

**Town of Sumner
Town Board Meeting
Town Hall, 1550 24 ½ Street, Town of Sumner, Wisconsin
Tuesday, April 9, 2019**

Meeting called to order by Town Board Chair Steven Palmquist at 7:00 p.m. Present: Supervisors Steve Becker, Kevin Crotteau; Clerk Sandra Tomczak, and patrolman David Etlicher.

Clerk verified proper public notice. Moved by Crotteau/Becker to approve the agenda. No negative vote. Reports given by Clerk and Patrolman. Moved by Crotteau/Becker to approve the minutes of the March 2019 regular meeting. No negative vote.

Public Comment. Joy Bartsch: suggested that when board members help with snow plowing and other work for the town they should report how much time is volunteered. It would give the board a more accurate picture of how much time it takes to plow roads and help the full-time patrolman with other tasks. Laura Gifford: Concerns regarding the condition of 17th Avenue, when will it be blacktopped?

Discussion: notice to Tim Peterson regarding 2 wood piles on road right of way on 26th Street. Supervisor Crotteau noticed that one pile is leaning on the road and is a safety hazard. Both piles are in the road right-of-way. Mr. Peterson was in attendance and stated one pile has been there since 2005 with no prior comment from board. Mr. Peterson plans to remove the wood pile closest to the road once the road bans are off. The board will monitor the situation. No public notice will be sent at this time.

The sale of the Diamond T trailer will be on the May agenda once the board looks at the trailer's condition and will set the price at that time.

Glenn Hanson has been suggested as a possible casual part-time patrolman as he has grader experience and is recently retired. A board member will talk to him before it is placed on a future agenda.

Moved Crotteau/Palmquist to appoint Steve Becker to the Cameron Fire Department Board. Motion carried without negative vote.

Roads considered to be classified as Class "B" are: 30th Street, 17th Ave from 25th St to 27th St, 12 3/4 Ave from 24th St) to 27th St, 15½ - 16th Ave (Old 14) to county line. The town board will need to set standards, document everything, and develop a conditional use permit.

Cleanup day is set for May 11, 2019. Supervisor Becker will check on what the Town of Stanley is doing for electronics recycling and inform the clerk as to suggested fees.

Correspondence was shared with the board.

Suggested agenda items for next meeting: if needed, discuss notice to Tim Peterson regarding the wood piles on the road right-of-way on 26th Street, setting a price for the Diamond T Trailer, hire an additional Casual Part-Time Patrolman, discuss classification of some town roads as class "B", allow publication of request for gravel bids.

Moved by Becker/Crotteau to approve the payment of bills covered with checks 10853-10879.
No negative vote.

The next regular Town Board meeting is set for Tuesday, May 7, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. Yearly road inspection meeting set for Tuesday, April 23, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. Board of Review meeting required to be held during the 45-day period beginning the 4th Monday of April is set for May 7, 2019 at 6:50 p.m. Open book set for June 4, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. The Board of Review initial 2-hour meeting is set for June 11, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
