## Resolution to Discontinue Public Way

The Town Board of the Town of Sumner, Barron County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

The street described below is vacated and discontinued under s. 66.1003 (4), Wis. stats. It is in the public interest that the street described below is vacated and discontinued under s. 66.1003 (4), Wis. stats. The street to be discontinued is described as follows:

Being all that portion of 26 ½ Street right of way located north of the following described line.

Commencing at the North ¼ of said Section 28 Thence south along the north-south ¼ line a distance of 2560.00 feet; Thence westerly at right angles to the north-south ¼ line to a point on the westerly right of way of 26 ½ Street being the point of beginning of the line to be described; Thence easterly perpendicular to the north-south ¼ line to the easterly right of way of 26 ½ Street and there said line terminating.

Excepting therefrom any lands located within the right of way of USH 8.

The discontinuance of the above-described street will not result in a landlocked property and no owner of property abutting the discontinued alley will be damaged by the discontinuance. The discontinued street will be vacated and the land to be attached to the adjoining properties.

CSP Property Holdings LLC will make an annual payment of \$5,000.00 to the Township for each year the road is under CSP's control.

The road shall be rebuilt and returned to the Township pursuant to a Town Road Rebuild and Donation Agreement. The rebuilt road shall be completed pursuant to Wisconsin Department of Transportation standards and shall be completed no later than 10 years after the road is deconstructed by CSP Property Holdings LLC.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
