Town of Sumner-Town Board Meeting

Attending: Chairperson Palmquist, Supervisors Steve Becker and Kevin Crotteau. Treasurer Jenn Harder. Clerk Sandra Tomczak. Patrolman Cory Svoma.

1. Call to order: Chairperson Steven Palmquist.
2. Verification of proper public notice: Clerk Tomczak verified.
3. Approval of Agenda by Board: M/S/P Crotteau/Becker to approve the agenda. No negative vote.
4. Reports and Correspondence: Treasurer and Clerk reports given. Patrolman reported 2011 truck is back from repair shop and works.
5. January Minutes: M/S/P Crotteau/Becker to approve the minutes. No negative vote.
6. Place Building Permits on file: None

8. Canton Park Committee progress report: More donations coming in. Scott Tubbs is in charge of playground equipment installation when it arrives in April.
9. Request by property owner at 2404 US8 that town issue a citation to a contractor who did not get a building permit. House condemned due to asbestos contamination. M/S/P Crotteau/Becker to deny the request of issuing a citation to the contractor who did not get a building permit at 2404 US8. No negative vote.
10. Discuss quotes for the purchase of new dump/plow truck. M/S/P Crotteau/Becker to accept the Midstates quote for \$205,771.12; \$1000 less if not aluminum wheels, other options accepted: stainless steel toolbox for \$670, stainless steel (lubricating) tubes with short hoses \$903. No negative vote.
11. Discuss projects for supplemental local road projects grants through WisDOT Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Funding. Chair will discuss what options town may have with Commissioner Servi at Barron County Highway Dept.
12. Change cemetery policy to not allow reservation of graves without full payment. M/S/P Becker/Crotteau that option 3 language to change cemetery policy be adopted. New policy on file.
13. Discuss employee job descriptions. Clerk to retype draft clerk job description and bring back to board.
14. Hire part-time casual patrolman helper: M/S/P Crotteau/Becker to hire Steve Losey as part time casual patrolman helper. No negative vote.
15. Informal Public Comment: none
16. Items intended for future meetings: Building Permit Ordinance and/or UDC ordinance revisions. Quotes for new furnace/AC and allocation of ARPA grant money to pay for it.
