Ordinance 2022-02
Designation of Class B Highways

The Town Board of the Town of Sumner, Barron County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under Section 349.15 (2), Wisconsin Statutes, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

- A. Town of Sumner Ordinance No: 2019-02 is repealed and replaced with the following:
- B. The following town highways in the Town of Sumner are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in Section 348.16 (2), Wisconsin Statutes, unless increased by town ordinance:

17th Avenue from 25th Street to 27th Street
12 $\frac{3}{4}$ Avenue from 24th Street to 30th Street
27th Street from 17th Avenue south to Chetek Town Line

- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the weight limits set forth in Section 348.16 (2), Wisconsin Statutes. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance shall be effective on September 14, 2022.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under Section 60.80 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Adopted this 13th day of September, 2022.
