1. Call to order: Chair Palmquist. Supervisors Zimmer and Tubbs attending.
2. Pledge of Allegiance: Recited
3. Verification of proper public notice. Clerk Tomczak
4. Approval of Agenda by Board. Moved Zimmer/Tubbs to approve. No negative vote.
5. Consider going into closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 19.85(1)(c), to evaluate employees' performance. Move Tubbs/Zimmer. Oral Vote was unanimous.
6. Return to open session. Moved Tubbs/Zimmer. Oral vote was unanimous.
7. Appoint Clerk Tomczak to 2 year term beginning April 21, 2026 and ending April 18, 2028. Moved Tubbs/Zimmer to appoint for 90 days beginning April 21. No negative vote.
8. Appoint Treasurer Harder to 2 year term beginning April 21, 2026 and ending April 18, 2028. Moved Tubbs Zimmer to appoint Treasurer Harder to 2 year term beginning April 21, 2026 and ending April 18, 2028.
9. Resolution redefining relationship of park committee to town board. Zimmer presented a written policy stating the current way things will be done. Move Zimmer/Tubbs to reject the draft resolution. No negative vote.
10. Resolution Supporting a Comprehensive and Sustainable Transportation Funding Solution. Moved Zimmer/Tubbs to approve. No negative vote.

Supervisor Zimmer stated there were 2 more items that need immediate action and did not want to have another meeting.

Moved Zimmer/Tubbs to approve the zoning change for the park concession building project. No negative vote.

Moved Zimmer/Tubbs that we request DNR approval to drill the well at the park. No negative vote.
